

## Checklist: Things to bring

- Important papers such as passport, insurance, travel information and information leaflets you received von ISU Darmstadt beforehand
- Some cash for the first days
- Credit card/debit card and PIN-number (make sure that your card is valid in Europe/Germany)
- Comfortable shoes, also suitable for hiking
- Clothes for warm and cool days
- Raincoat and/or umbrella
- Dress clothes for ceremonies, such as presentation of certificates
- Adapter and converter for any electrical devices (e.g. laptop, mobile phone, hairdryer) you may want to bring. German appliances work on 220 Volt
- Swimsuit or swim trunks
- Any medication (i.e. for allergy) you may need
- International SIM-card. It might be very expensive to use your normal phone card, so maybe it is a good idea to check out prices for international ones. You can also purchase international phone cards in Germany.
- German dictionary in your language

Please be aware, that you have to carry your suitcase from the airport to your accommodation and also on the trip to southern Germany. Don't pack too much!
